New Features & Improvements

Laravel Update

What it does:

trakr **Counting** has been upgraded to Laravel 11, enhancing performance, security, and access to the latest features.

Why it matters:

User Time Zone Management

What it does:

- Administrators can modify user time zones in the Users section.

Inventory Management

Inventory Counting Time Zone

What it does:

Printer Label Update

Default Storage for New Customers (Pilot Users Only)

Upon signup, new customers will receive a base storage tree to help them learn about the new feature.

Product Management

Product Detail Overrides (Pilot Users Only)

What it does:

Users can now override the on-hand quantity of a product directly from the product details screen.



Why it matters:

This gives users more control over inventory data, making it easier to manage product quantities accurately.

Auto Barcode Generator Fix

What it does:

Provided this setting is enabled, the auto barcode generator uses the SKU correctly when creating a new product without a barcode.

Why it matters:

This fix ensures that barcodes are generated correctly, reducing errors and improving product management.

Bulk Add to Storage (Pilot Users Only)

What it does:

Users can now bulk assign multiple products to one or more storage locations simultaneously.

Why it matters:

Product Storage Search (Pilot Users Only)

A new search and filter option allows users to filter products by their assigned storage locations.
